Khar-ah Cheerfulness, that is a calm delight, gladness.

Primary verb – to be full of cheer, that is calmly happy or well off. To be well.

Romans 7:22 To rejoice in the law of Jehovah.

Also “meek”. Mild by implication. Humble. Blessed are the meek. Happy, easy, those who are of a quiet, gentle spirit (mind) in opposition to the proud.

(Delight) calm-Silence, still, astonished, subside

Peace

To join. Quietness, rest (state of reconcile) by implication, prosperity.

Perfect peace Isaiah 26:3 All who trust in you. All whose thoughts are fixed on you.

Peacemaker Matthew 5 Pacify. Quell the anger agitation or excitement of. Appease.
Calm

Longsuffering

Patience, endurance, constancy, steadfastness, perseverance

Slowness in wrongs—A disposition to bear injuries patiently. Long enduring temper. Fortitude.

Gentleness

Usefulness, that is a moral excellence, in character, or demeanor. Also translated kindness. Upright of mind and life.

Considerate in disposition, mild in mood, soft, tender, well managed, not sudden or rash or angry, taking care not to harm others.

James 3:11 Bitter and sweet water

Goodness (Functional)

Matthew 7:17-19 Tree good, fruit will be good
12:33 A tree is known by its fruit

Faith

Persuasion-to be convinced. That is credence. Fidelity. Faithfulness to a person, a cause or belief demonstrated by continuing loyalty and support. Allegiance, obedience, constancy, staunchness, fastness.

Hebrews 11 More to "Faithfulness" and "Fidelity". As produced in the life of the yielded believer by the word of the Father, who is persuaded or convinced.

Temperance

Self-control. Continence; control movements, self-restraint.

Derived from 'even & krato. "Strength". Reference to the power or ascendancy which we have over exciting and dysfunctional passions of all kinds.
